

The following Adamthwaites were located living in workhouses in the Censuses:

1841 census:

Edwd Adamthwaite, b1770 in Kensington Workhouse – (son Wm and Jane (Stevenson) YELLOW line)

1851 census:

Mary Adamthwaite, b 1775, recipient of Lady Pembroke Charity, in St Ann's Hospital Appleby (*see right*) – (widow of William, Mary (Sayer) – GREY line)

William Adamthwaite, b 1807, receiving parish relief in Sedbergh – (son of Rev William Adamthwaite and Jane McEver – VIOLET line)

1861 census:

Mary Adamthwaite, b 1780, inmate in Paddington Workhouse – (widow of Edward Adamthwaite, Mary (Newbury) YELLOW line)

Mary Adamthwaite, b 1775, almswoman at St Anns Hospital, Appleby – (widow of William, Mary (Sayer) – GREY line)

John Adamthwaite, b 1797, inmate at Kirkby Stephen Workhouse – believe he could be son of Wm and Hannah Whitesmith who was born 1802 - BLUE line.

1891 census:

Edwin Adamthwaite, b 1819, patient at St Cuthberts Joint counties Lunatic Asylum, Cumberland (*see right*) – (son of Rev William Adamthwaite and Sarah (Flower), OLIVE line)

Charles Adamthwaite, b 1830, inmate at Paddington Workhouse – (son of Edward and Mary (Newbury), YELLOW line)

1901 census:

Elizabeth Adamthwaite, b 1841, living in Shoreditch Almshouses (*now the site of the Geffrye Museum see right*) – (widow of John Jonathan Adamthwaite, BLUE line)

Henry Adamthwaite, b1821, inmate at Kensington Workhouse – (son Edward and Mary (Newbury), YELLOW line)

Deaths in the Workhouse

1845 **Edward Adamthwaite**, son Wm and Jane (Stephenson) died in Kensington Workhouse – YELLOW line

1863 **John Adamthwaite** age 66 - could be son of Wm and Hannah (Whitesmith), died in Kirkby Stephen Workhouse - BLUE line

1865 **Joseph James Adamthwaite**, son Edward and Mary (Newbury) died in Paddington Workhouse – YELLOW line

1867 **Mary Adamthwaite** (nee Newbury), wife of Edward Adamthwaite, died in Paddington Workhouse – YELLOW line

1894 **Charles Newbury Adamthwaite**, son of Edward and Mary (Newbury) died in Paddington Infirmary – YELLOW line

1901 **Henry Edward Adamthwaite**, son of Edward and Mary (Newbury) died in Kensington Infirmary – YELLOW line

1905 **Elizabeth Adamthwaite**, widow of John Jonathan, died in Shoreditch Almshouses in Edmonton – BLUE line

1912 **John Alexander Adamthwaite**, son of John Allen Adamthwaite and Eliza (Saynor) died in Workhouse Isolation Hospital at Barnet – ORANGE line

1917 **Charles Frederick Adamthwaite**, son Henry and Jane (Marriner) died in Kensington Infirmary – YELLOW line
